UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

TABULATION OF BIDS:

- a) Mr. Mike Presta from Prein and Newhof recommended the Council award the contract to Balkema Excavating for lead service line replacement in the amount of \$152,000.
- Mr. Presta stated this project includes replacing lead pipe service lines at 33 addresses, between the road and the home.
- Village Manager Cheri Lutz stated that \$100,000 of the cost would come from ARPA funds issued by Kalamazoo County.

- b) Village Manager Cheri Lutz led a discussion regarding resurfacing Lyon Street, from US 131 to 14th Street.
 - She made the following statements:
- She stated the cost of the project is estimated to be \$79,000.
- She stated the work will be done by Kalamazoo County Road Commission.
- She stated the railroad tracks on E. Lyon Street will also be worked on.
- She stated striping the road is not included in this cost.

Motion by Mastenbrook, seconded by Rance to award the bid to Kalamazoo County Road Commission to resurface E. Lyon Street. By Roll Call, all aye.

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NEW BUSINESS:

The memorandum from Village Manager Cheri Lutz regarding Mercury Fiber installing fiber optics for high speed internet was discussed.

Village Manager Lutz made the following statement:

• She stated there are a few details that need to be submitted to Mr. Mike Presta from Prein and Newhof for approval.

Representatives from Mercury Broadband, Directline, and Troyer Group were present.
