

**VILLAGE OF SCHOOLCRAFT
PLANNING COMMISSION
JUNE 12, 2017**

The Regular Meeting of the Planning Commission held at 442 N. Grand Street, Schoolcraft, Michigan, was called to order by Chairperson Tim Brown at 7:00 p.m.
